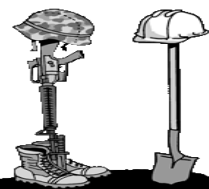

Please be advised that the IBEW Founders' Scholarship is available to IBEW members who have been

in continuous good standing for the four years preceding May 1st of the scholarship year. If a member has been on honorary withdrawal, at any time during the aforementioned period, he/she will not be eligible to participate.

Unfortunately, the IBEW Founders' Scholarship is not available to the spouses or children of IBEW members. How-



ever, Union Plus has a scholarship that is available for IBEW members, as well as members' spouses and dependent children (as defined under IRS Regulations).
