

## ACCIDENTAL DEATH and DISMEMBERMENT

### Description:

Pays a Principal Sum for accidental loss of life or dismemberment.

### Source and Amount:

- **LINECO, Accidental Death and Dismemberment (AD&A)**
- A Principle Sum in the amount equal to a maximum of **\$20,000**

*Note: Refer to the Lineco Summary Plan Disruption (SPD) book or on the internet at Lineco.org, Benefit Summary or SPD; **Accidental Death and Dismemberment**, for complete details and of eligibility requirements for this benefit.*

And

- **IBEW Local 769 – Management Health and Welfare Plan, Accidental Death and Dismemberment (AD&A)**
- A Principle Sum in an amount equal to a maximum of **\$30,000** and with a accidental death an additional **\$20,000**

And

- **IBEW “A” Members, Accidental Death Benefit**
- A Principle Sum in the amount equal to **\$6,250** accidental death only

*Note: Refer to the IBEW Constitution, Article 11 Sec. 4; Death Benefit, for complete details and of eligibility requirements for this benefit.*

Example: For an **Accidental Death**: [\$20,000 (Lineco) + \$50,000 (Local 769) + \$6,250 (IBEW)] + \$46,250 (Accumulated Life Insurance amount) = **\$122,500 plus the spouse would receive a life time monthly amount from IBEW Local 769-Management Pension.**

For **Loss of a Hand**: [\$10,000 (Lineco) + \$15,000 (local 769) = **\$25,000**
